

**RECOMMENDED EXTENSION OF ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR STAY
IN PART AND GRANTING MOTION FOR STAY IN PART**

Appellee moves the Department of Business Regulation to extend DBR Order No. 11-037, attached hereto, because the City of Providence Board of Licenses has not yet rendered a final decision on this matter that took place last week. The parties came before the undersigned Hearing Officer on May 4, 2011 at 11:55AM. After consideration of the arguments presented by the Appellee and Appellant, the following order is recommended:

DBR Order No. 11-037 is extended to: (1) grant a stay to the Appellee for the limited purpose of operating under the business format of Lupo's on Wednesday, May 4, 2011 during the business hours normally operated by the Appellee and subject to the Appellee obtaining an entertainment license from the City of Providence; and (2) deny the stay in all other aspects and prohibit the Appellee from acting under any other business format, including, the Roxy. In the event the City of Providence does not issue a final decision in this matter, the Department expects the parties to return to undersigned Hearing Officer if an extension of this Order is sought.




