The above-entitled matter came on for pre-hearing conference on May 19, 2009 pursuant to the Department of Business Regulation's ("Department") Order to Show Cause and Notice of Hearing ("Notice") issued by the Department on April 22, 2009 to David Beaulieu ("Respondent"). At the pre-hearing conference, the parties agreed to a temporary cease and desist order being entered against the Respondent from engaging in any unlicensed autowrecking and salvage activity. 


