FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL


The above-entitled matter came for pre-hearing conference on April 23, 2009 pursuant to the Department of Business Regulation's ("Department") Order to Show Cause and Notice of Hearing ("Notice") issued by the Department on April 1, 2009 to Stanley Paquin ("Respondent"). 2. The temporary cease and desist order issued on April 27, 2009 is vacated.



THE AGENCY MAY GRANT, OR THE REVIEWING COURT MAY ORDER, A STAY UPON THE APPROPRIATE TERMS.
