ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED

1. Defendants IMF and Hemphill shall comply with said Subpoena Duces Tecum issued by the DBR on December 3, 2008 forthwith;
2. Defendants IMF and Hemphill shall cease and desist from engaging in any activity requiring registration or licensure by the DBR;
3. Defendants IMF and Hemphill shall refrain from altering, tampering, or otherwise interfering with the accuracy or integrity of the records, documents, and items covered by the Subpoena Duces Tecum;

5. The DBR may utilize the assistance of local and state police in aiding compliance with this Order.


