Auto Wrecking and Salvage Yard licenses will expire as of June 30, 2009. A completed renewal package must be returned to this Department no later than May 30, 2009. In order to renew your license please follow the steps listed on the application instruction sheet attached to this renewal package. Please note that the fee for licensure has been raised to \$250.00 per year pursuant to Budget Article 33 as related to Business Regulation, passed by the legislature on July 1, 2008. This is a three-year license: please include a check or money order payable to the Rhode Island General Treasurer in the amount of \$750.00.

Please note that there have been changes to the application. The Application will not be accepted if all items required are not submitted along with the application and will be returned to you unprocessed.
