**NOTICE OF REAL ESTATE LICENSE RENEWAL PROCESS  
FOR BROKERS AND SALESPERSONS**

All Real Estate Licenses will expire on 04/30/08.

The Department of Business Regulation, Real Estate section, has changes its procedure for renewing all real estate licenses in order to create a more efficient license renewal process.

It is now mandatory that all licensees renew on-line at [www.ri.gov](http://www.ri.gov) or you may use the Department website at [www.dbr.state.ri.us](http://www.dbr.state.ri.us) and follow instructions for on-line renewal.

The Department is confident that this procedure will expedite the license renewal process for our licensees and enable the Department to mail licenses on a more frequent basis.

**YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION.**

Please be sure that the Department has your correct home and business address for any future mailings. It is your responsibility to notify this office of any change of address.

**CONTINUING EDUCATION**

**MANDATORY COURSE REQUIREMENT PER RULE 34.** You are required to complete a course of at least three (3) clock hours, approved by the Real Estate Commission, regarding the changes to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-20.6-1, *et seq.*, the statute defining relationships in real estate transactions. This law was amended on July 6, 2007 and becomes effective on May 1, 2008. This course may be used as part of the 18-hour continuing education requirement. If you have already met this requirement, this course may be used for the next renewal period ending April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
