1. Summary of Significant Accounting Practices

A. Accounting Practices

The financial statements of Pawtucket Insurance Company are presented on the basis of accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the Rhode Island Insurance Department.

The Rhode Island Insurance Department recognizes only statutory accounting practices prescribed or permitted by the State of Rhode Island for determining and reporting financial condition and results of operations on an insurance company, and for determining its solvency under the Rhode Island Insurance Law. The National Association of Insurance Commissioners' ("NAIC") Accounting Practices and Procedures manual, ("NAIC SAP"), has been adopted as a component of prescribed or permitted practices by the State of Rhode Island.

The prepayment model uses a number of factors to estimate prepayment activity including the time of year (seasonality), current levels or interest rates (refinancing incentive), economic activity (including housing turnover) and term and age of the underlying collateral (burnout, seasoning).

Reserves as of December 31, 2009 were \$2.7 million. As of March 31, 2010, \$0.3 million has been paid for net incurred claims and claim adjustment expenses attributable to insured events of prior years. Reserves remaining for prior policy years are now \$2.3 million as a result of re-estimation of unpaid claims and claim adjustment expenses principally on the homeowners' line of insurance. Therefore, there has been a \$0.1 million favorable prior-year development since December 31, 2009 to March 31, 2010. The decrease is generally the result of ongoing analysis of recent loss development trends. Original estimates are increased or decreased as additional information becomes available. The Company does not issue retrospectively rated policies.
