

Bulletin CL-RE-2010-5

Real Estate Continuing Education

The intent of this bulletin is to clarify Section 30 of Commercial Licensing Regulation 11 for Real Estate Brokers and Salespersons ("CLR 11") as it relates to the educational requirements for attorneys licensed by the Supreme Court of this state who opt to obtain a real estate broker's license or real estate salesperson's license pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §5-20.5-4(d) ("Attorney Licensees").

1. Attorney Licensees shall obtain twenty-four (24) clock hours of educational credits during the preceding 2 year period prior to the renewal of licensure.
2. Attorney Licensees shall receive full credit for all mandatory continuing legal education ("MCLE") approved by the Supreme Court.
3. Attorney Licensees must obtain four (4) clock hours of credits from the subject areas enumerated in CLR 11 Section 30(D). To be clear, MCLE courses approved by the Supreme Court that fall under the categories listed in CLR 11 Section 30 (D) automatically apply to this requirement.
