**Insurance Claim Adjusters and Insurance Appraisers Examination
after Expiration of Licenses**

Effective immediately, Insurance Claim Adjuster licensees and Insurance Appraiser licensees (collectively "Licensees") who allow their licenses to expire have until one (1) year from the date of expiration to file a new application for a license and not have to retake the appropriate examination for licensing. Licensees must still complete and file a new application and file the appropriate reissuance affidavit.

If a Licensees' license has expired for more than one (1) year from the date of expiration, the Licensee must also take the appropriate examination in order to apply for a new license.
