

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arose from an appeal filed by Zayas Solutions, LLC d/b/a Tafino Restaurant and Lounge, (“Appellant”) with the Department of Business Regulation (“Department”) pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 3-7-21 regarding a decision taken by the City of Providence, Board of Licenses (“Board”) on March 13, 2017 denying the Appellant’s application for a Class BVX (2:00 a.m. closing) liquor license. A hearing was held on March 31, 2017 before the undersigned with the parties resting on the record. The parties were represented by counsel. By decision dated May 12, 2017, this matter was remanded back to the Board for further consideration consistent with said decision. On January 29, 2018, the Appellant informed the undersigned that this matter was resolved and that this matter could be dismissed. Therefore, based on the forgoing, the Appellant’s appeal is dismissed.


